Seal Tours, Thursday, June 13. The Alumni Association has reserved space on the Seal Tour sightseeing ride of San Diego, San Diego Bay and Mission Bay. The 90-minute ride departs from Seaport Village Old Town Trolley stop at 10 a.m. The tour craft, a boat on wheels, is similar to those used in Branson, Missouri. The regular price is \$24. Our cost is \$20, **provided at least 15 of us show up.** The first two hours of parking at Seaport Village are free with a validation from one of the Village merchants.

Carrizo Gorge Railway Ride, Saturday, October 26. The Alumni Association offers a six-hour vintage train ride adventure through tunnels and over bridges through East San Diego County to Tecate, Mexico. Tecate has friendly people and a slower pace of life. Dine and shop at a variety of restaurants and stores and the Central Park booths. Take a walking tour of the Tecate Brewery (when available). You will have several hours to enjoy the town.

Departure time is 10 a.m.; return about 4 p.m. The ride starts at the Campo depot. From San Diego take I-8 east for about 50 miles. Exit at the Buckman Springs Road; follow Buckman Springs Road southward for 10 miles. The road ends at Hiway 94; turn right. After you cross the tracks, turn left at the first street, Forrest Gate Road, then left again at the second driveway, and the San Diego Railroad Museum sign.

From downtown San Diego, travel time is 1 hour 10 minutes.

The regular price for this trip is \$40 each. We are getting a special rate of \$20 each for adults; children are \$10 each. Bring along water or soft drinks, if you choose.


