SDG&E's Clean Transportation Program

SDG&E's Clean Transportation Program was awarded Corporate Innovator of the Year at MOVE San Diego's 2nd Annual Celebrating Green Streets on October 27 for its role in helping identify, install and debut San Diego's first public electric vehicle charging unit in Balboa Park.

SDG&E's efforts with the City of San Diego and others successfully led to Car2Go's car-sharing program to select America's Finest City as the first place in the world to launch an all-electric car sharing programs.

The program will bring 300 new electric vehicles to town. By year-end over 1,000 electric vehicle owners will be charging in their own garages and public locations.
