## SDG&E recognized as Corporate Philanthropist of Year

San Diego Gas & Electric (SDG&E) took home top honors as Outstanding Corporate Philanthropist of the Year at the annual Association of Fundraising Professionals (AFP) awards luncheon on October 25. During the awards ceremony, SDG&E was recognized for its generosity, corporate giving strategy, strong commitment to the community and its employees who donate their money and time to the charitable organizations they care about. Over the last 10 years, the Sempra Energy family of companies has given back more than \$120 million to charitable causes, and in 2011, SDG&E gave over \$5 million to causes in San Diego alone.

# **SDG&E** Partners With the Burn Institute to Offer Fire and Burn Prevention for Seniors Program

If you are 62 or older and own your own home, you are qualified for the Burn Institute's FREE smoke alarms for seniors program. The Burn Institute will install new smoke alarms, inspect existing smoke alarms, and replace batteries in existing units with 10-year lithium batteries. Smoke alarms for the hearing impaired are also available. Together with the Burn Institute and community volunteers [including SDG&E employee volunteers], this program provides fire and burn prevention for seniors.
